Johnston McCulley, periodista y escritor norteamericano, nació en 1887 en Los Ángeles, California. Estudió derecho en la Universidad de Santa Barbara, comenzó a escribir para el periódico "The Times" de Santa Barbara. Su primera "El Zorro" apareció en el periódico en 1919. La serie se publicó en el periódico durante 10 años. McCulley ganó el premio Pulitzer en 1933 por su trabajo en el periódico. A pesar de su éxito, su salud se deterioró y murió en 1958.
